SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. President. The amendment that I'm offering makes a correction to the state claims bill by deleting one of the claims that we had approved. We found that the bill had already been accounted for in the original claims bill. The Lincoln County Attorney had double-billed on that claim for representing the state in administrative license revocation appeals. State Claims Board believes the double-billing to be two separate...believe the double-billing to be two, separate claims and we have come to find out that that's...this is not the case. So I ask for your support in deleting the claim that's found on page 1 in the E & R amendments; this is in the amount of \$3,950, because it's already been accounted for in a claim that we allowed before. If you have any questions, I'll try to answer those. With that, I would ask you to support the amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Debate on the adoption of AM2949? Senator Vrtiska, you're recognized to close. Senator Vrtiska waives closing.
