SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Purchasing.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Purchasing, is it that purchasing is more accurate than procurement or that it's more genteel than procurement?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: You know, I didn't hear their explanation of it but it probably is both.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I'm going to follow Senator Wehrbein's lead again, I'll support the amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Wehrbein, would you like to close? Senator Wehrbein waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM2810 to LB 1216. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.
