CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Coordsen's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1216 to E & R for engrossing.
