Senator Tyson waives closing. The question is the adoption of AM2935 to LB 1217. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Tyson's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is agreed to. (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment, Senator Chambers, FA320. I have a note, Senator, you'd like to withdraw FA320 and offer as a substitute AM2936.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And, Mr. Clerk, I will withdraw that one also.

CLERK: AM2936, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

CLERK: Okay.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The amendment is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Chambers, I now have what is FA321 with a note again, Senator, you want to withdraw and substitute AM2937. (Legislative Journal page 1170.)

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, and I want to take that one up.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Without objection to the substitution, so ordered. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President and members of the Legislature, this amendment is to strike some money from the State Patrol's budget. It would be found on page 16 of the E & R amendments, page 16, line 17. Before I proceed, I would like to ask Senator Wehrbein a question or two.
