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SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Wehrbein, the guidance that I have on this so far is found in the yellow publication that you handed out to us dealing with various expenditures and I'm on page 11,...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...where it lists the State Patrol. It says Community Oriented Police Services. What exactly is that, if you know?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I do, if you give me about two seconds,...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Sure.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: ...if you can talk a minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh, I should continue.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, I...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I want to be sure that this is not money that we took from that DARE Program, which the State Patrol had been getting federal money for, they had said that if we funded them one more time, they wouldn't come back again. We funded them. The money ran out. They came back again, and I want to be sure that under the guise of this offering, they are not doing the same thing, and I would like to know precisely what kind of community oriented policing the State Patrol is providing. The mere statement or heading is not enough to convince me that this amount of money ought to be expended. So what my amendment would do is to strike \$176,814.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Okay, I'm ready, I'm with you now.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, Senator Wehrbein, would you explain what that program...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right.
