Bionic Woman".) I don't think the university is taking this matter seriously. Anything that they take seriously they get done and it doesn't take them forever. They wanted to undertake an extensive renovation of Memorial Stadium and they got that done. They wanted to include very expensive sky boxes which would raise tons of revenue. They got that done. They wanted to install a high-tech scoreboard system. They got that done. And then, when they need somebody to run up and down the gridiron to generate millions of dollars, literally, in revenue, they don't have any trouble recruiting large numbers, substantial numbers let me say, of minority athletes. So they can recruit us to run up and down the football field to make money for them, but they cannot recruit us to be in the classroom and I find that to be ironic, to say the least. I did not put in this amendment that they should have to contract with the Athletic Department for consultants to tell them how to recruit minority people. Look at the roster when that Nebraska football team is out there. Where do the minorities come from and where do they live? The university says, well, these...there aren't many black people in Lincoln so...black people and other minorities don't want to live here so we don't, you know, we don't even bother about that. When we go there we tell them, oh, Lincoln is probably one of the whitest places you will ever see in your life; you can go anywhere in the world and it won't be as white as Lincoln; you don't want to come here. Then they run back and tell us, well, you know, what these people said is that there's no minority community so they don't want to come there. I'm not going to let the university palm their responsibility off on somebody else when they show that in every other area where they want minorities and it's to their benefit and actually produces revenue, they can find all that they need. They can bring them from California on the west; they can bring them from New York on the east, New Jersey. They even reach up into Canada and they'll reach across the ocean and bring these people here, like the old spiritual says, bringing in the sheaves, bringing in the sheaves, we shall come rejoicing bringing in the sheaves. And when the sheaves are going to put on football uniforms with numbers and rip and run up and down that football field, tote that ball, lift that weight, then you're all right; we can find plenty of you...
