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be reduced by this amount. I'm not reducing it. I'm saying you talk about having a problem, then this money is going to be directed through legislative enactment to the achieving of this purpose that the Legislature said you should achieve. And that's what the purpose is. If people think this is too much, then they should tell me what they think would be more reasonable to achieve this purpose.

SENATOR SUTTLE: Thank you, Senator Chambers. I think that we should study it too. In fact, I'm working on some...a resolution as we speak, now I won't have to if this amendment passes, to study this issue as a legislative interim study and would support that. Three point six million for just this purpose would be great if it were all new money. I think maybe this might be a little bit too much, but I, too, will listen to the discussion. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Suttle. Mr. Clerk, is there an amendment to the bill?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Kristensen would move to amend Senator Chambers' amendment. (FA337, Legislative Journal page 1191.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kristensen, you're recognized to open on your amendment to AM2982 to LB 1217.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Senator Chambers, I put an amendment up here that, one, I'm serious about but, two, there were...there were not enough lights here that I'm worried about this discussion not getting its full...full discussion points either. I'll tell you what the amendment does briefly. It cuts the...it cuts Senator Chambers' amendment down to \$1.5 million. But, Senator Chambers, what I'm trying to understand is your amendment basically directed that \$3.6 million be spent towards the recruitment of...oh, I'm looking for the language here, for recruitment, development, and retention of minority and women faculty at the university. Is that...and I want to make sure that I understand what recruitment, development, and retention is. I'm not real crazy about money being spent to develop a program where people fly all over the country looking for people
