further on the bill?

CLERK: Nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1379
to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Heard the motion to advance LB 1379. Those
in favor please say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is
advanced. Next item, Mr. Clerk.
