use for dislocated workers. So there's some monetary changes which will enhance the problem...the program, enhance the programs for Nebraskans, for adult services, youth services, dislocated workers especially. So there's some important financial changes with the implementation of Workforce Investment Act, and this amendment does give the Legislature voting rights and the four members. The four members will be appointed by the presiding officer of the Legislature which is what is mandated by the federal government. There's various and sundry other changes if anyone wants to ask about them. Again, these were all agreed on by the Department of Labor. What we wanted to make sure is that as many of the concerns that we knew about were reflected in this amendment. There's one significant change that I certainly wanted to see that they've agreed to, is that the Chairperson of the Business and Labor Committee will receive a copy of the state plan or any modification of the state plan and a copy of the annual report of the state board is changed. These documents will be given to each member of the Business and Labor Committee so this is further empowerment and further engagement with your Business and Labor Committee as Workforce Investment Act proceeds to be implemented in the state of Nebraska. I think these are positive changes. It keeps us up to speed on things. It gives us a voice and would encourage the body to join with me in adopting AM2957. Thank you.
