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bill...against the bill. I'm going to vote against Senator Beutler's amendment. It's not more alluring to me. They're the same businesses that they were before. They're the same ones who are taking the risks that others are supposed to take who are in business. They still constitute a closed class of people who are given a break that nobody else is being given. Senator Baker...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...and the other retailers who are required to do certain things with these tanks are not going to get any consideration, but the broadcasters have power. They're the ones who not only form public opinion but they express public opinions about what we do, and it is wise to cheese up to them. That's what's at play. That's why Walt Radcliffe is on this bill, and Walt is at work. I don't just see Walt's fingerprints. I see his footprints.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Jones, followed by Senators Landis, Wickersham.

SENATOR JONES: Mr. President, members of the body, well, the bill got cut in half, I can see that, but I'm going to still support this and I think that...I think it's important, especially for my little television stations out in the western part of the state. I think that's really important to give them just a little bit more time so they don't have to put up the money now. But something I think we got to think about on this, we're concerned about the tax we're going to lose. Well, if the federal mandate hadn't a come down there wouldn't a been no tax to start out with. This is something that's just coming to the state because of the federal mandate. So it came down and here all of a sudden this tax is going to come so we're trying to help it out on the state level to help them out just a little bit so they don't have to have too much expense, because this mandate's going to come down and they've got to do it. So I'm going to stand in support of Kristensen's amendment and then I'm going to support Senator Beutler's amendment too. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jones. Senator Landis, on the Kristensen amendment. Senator Landis.
