CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators please report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Price, would you please check in. Senator Matzke, would you check in, please. Senator Schimek. Senator Dierks, would you please check in, and Senator Dickey. The house is under call. Senator Kristensen has authorized call-ins. The house is under call. Senator Kristensen has authorized call-ins. Senator Dierks, would you please check in. The house is under call. Senator Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Who...who is missing, Senator?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Dierks.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Okay. When Senator Dierks arrives I'd like a roll call vote, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Dierks, the house is under call. Would you please check in. Senator Dierks is here. The question before the body is the Kristensen amendment to the Beutler amendment, AM2906, to LB 171. Senator Kristensen has requested a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1219.)  
25 ayes, 18 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Kristensen amendment to the Beutler amendment is adopted. I do raise the call. We are back on the Beutler amendment, AM2906, to LB 171. Open for discussion, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, before I start, is this the first time I'm speaking on the Beutler amendment?

SENATOR CUDABACK: This is your second time, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: On the Beutler amendment? All right, thank
