whatever reason, you have to go back and pay those taxes, the cost of money, the cost of what the county or whoever should have gotten should be added to that. That's the way it would be in any economic transaction. They should not get the free use of money for several years, and you should not create a situation where they might want to use that mechanism for simply having an interest free loan for a period of years. So I hope you see the logic of what's being done here. Thank you.
