SENATOR CUDABACK: Time. Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. We are debating the bracket motion for LB 1222. Senator Chambers, following by Senator Vrtiska and Senator Beutler. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I would like to ask Senator Vrtiska a question or two.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you yield, Senator Vrtiska?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Yes, I will.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Vrtiska, did you hear me say that it's my belief that anything in this bill which is of substance could be folded into LB 1438 (sic)? Did you hear me say that?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Yes, I heard that.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Did you hear me suggest that anything in this bill which is different from what is in LB 1438 (sic) that is deemed to be necessary could be amended into LB 1438 (sic)?

SENATOR VRTISKA: I heard you say that, but there are some things different about this bill and LB 1348. I and Senator Wehrbein discussed the possibility of molding these bills together but we see that they have some difference in the way they're made up and so therefore we didn't do it.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So is...I'd like to...is Senator Wehrbein back there? I can't see whether he is. Oh. I'd like to ask Senator Wehrbein a question or two.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Would you...
