SENATOR BEUTLER: Absolutely. And, Senator, speaking quite honestly, I really do believe that it's going to improve chances for funding for value-added agriculture because (interrupted)...

SENATOR VRTISKA: Given those circumstances, I would like to ask Senator Chambers one more question.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Would you be willing to withdraw your bracket motion if I ask the bill to be laid over so...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

SENATOR VRTISKA: ...that we can work on this without the bracket?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes, I will.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Given that circumstances, I would ask you to do that and I will in fact agree to work out an agreement.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Would you yield me some time?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Sure.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, I withdraw that bracket motion.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The bracket motion is withdrawn.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Senator Cudaback, I ask you to lay over LB 1222.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Is your request to pass the bill over?

SENATOR VRTISKA: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Seeing no objection, it is passed over.
