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SENATOR BOHLKE: This first year it's statewide, but eventually that would...there would be a report card showing how each district did with the combined average score of...

SENATOR RAIKES: And that's what you're demonstrating with this second handout, is that correct?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay. And so, well, I'm going to run out of time here. Take the first page of that second handout. We've got a list of...these are standards on the left, is that correct?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Correct.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay. And then you're going...each district then would report a number and a percent. Would it be in each one of those cells or would they just pick one of those cells? I'm not sure I understand how this might look once filled out.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Each district would know how they had done...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR BOHLKE: ...in each one...

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. Senator Schimek, on the Bohlke amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, members. Senator Raikes, if you'll turn your light on so I can have your time later, I will give you my time so you can continue this discussion because I want to hear some of these answers, too.
