SENATOR RAIKES: Okay, and then at the same time I would get a check in the quality of assessment row that said unacceptable.

SENATOR BOHLKE: That's right.

SENATOR RAIKES: So what that would tell me as a taxpayer is that my school district is claiming that their students do very well as compared to the standards, but an outside independent source says that their testing procedure is no good.

SENATOR BOHLKE: And I would think that if you were interested in looking at this you'd be calling your school district and saying why.

SENATOR RAIKES: ...of the information I'm going to get back out of this.

SENATOR RAIKES: And this does not include writing. Are you going to add writing into this?

SENATOR BOHLKE: Writing will be on there.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. Senator Schimek, you're recognized to speak on the Bohlke amendment.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. This is complicated, Senator Bohlke. And I am hoping...yes, go ahead.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Just hope that there won't be an assessment for all of you afterwards.
