SENATOR BOHLKE: It could be.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Could be, but it isn't, doesn't necessarily...

SENATOR BOHLKE: Does not have to be.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...doesn't have to be. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, and that was your last time. I should have told you, that was your last time. Senator Schimek, on the Bohlke amendment. Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I'd call the question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do see five hands. The question before the body is, shall debate cease on AM2784 to the committee amendments to LB 812? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? We are voting on ceasing debate. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Debate does cease on AM2784. Senator Bohlke, to close on that amendment, if you wish.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I would like to have a call of the house please as I begin to close.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There has been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of a call of the house vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. All unexcused senators please report to the Chamber. The house is under call.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you. Mr. President, I will proceed with
