PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Janssen would print amendments LB 973; Senator Landis to LB 932; Senator Beutler, LB 1348; and Senator Byars would offer a study resolution, LR 351. That will be referred to the Executive Board. And, Mr. President, the first series of bills read this morning on Final Reading were presented to the Governor at 10:25 a.m. (re: LB 1448, LB 1214, LB 1214A, LB 1215, LB 1216, LB 1217, LB 1328.) SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 414.
