SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Debate on the Schimek amendment. Senator Schimek, you're recognized to close. She waives closing. The question before the body is the adoption of the Schimek amendment. All those in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Schimek's amendment.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The Schimek amendment is adopted.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Bohlke.

SENATOR BOHLKE: Thank you, Mr. President and members. If you recall on General File we added some individuals to the task force. We added about five individuals. As we looked at the projections of what the cost of that task force may be, that projection was \$30,000. In discussing with Senator Coordsen how he generally sees how those things work out, it was my estimation and Senator Coordsen's that since we have added those five members to the task force that we probably will be adding...well, we will be adding some costs, and not only that, that we may have been underestimating, and I said I would feel more comfortable, and I asked Senator Coordsen about that, that if we could up the amount of the task force knowing then that we wouldn't be having overruns and having to go to the...to Senator Coordsen and asking for that extra amount. It's difficult to say it's going to cost exactly one amount but you remember the whole task force after we get done with all the work will be going to three congressional districts and doing town hall type meetings plus the national speaker.
