SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: And I...

SENATOR COORDSEN: It's a little...little change, but not much.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Okay, and that's the point I was interested in.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've still got the, obviously, the potential here of anybody could go and ask the Property Tax Administrator or the Property Tax Division to look at it. They could call that to their attention and they could also pull that in for review. I don't think that's been changed either and, with that, I plan to support the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Coordsen, there are no further lights on. Did you wish to close? Senator Coordsen waives closing. The question before the body is, shall AM2896 be adopted to LB 968? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Coordsen's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Coordsen amendment is adopted. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment is, Senator Wickersham, I have AM2836, but again a note, Senator, that you would like to withdraw that to allow Senator Coordsen to offer AM2479.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: That's correct.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Seeing no objection, it is so ordered.

CLERK: Senator Coordsen, AM2479. (AM2479, Legislative Journal page 928.)
