call, please check in. Senator Matzke, the house is under call, please check in. Senator Matzke is here. The question before the body is adoption of AM2910 to LB 968. Senator Landis has requested a roll call vote in reverse order. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1305-1306.) 18 ayes, 19 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Crosby-Bromm amendment is not adopted to LB 968. I do raise the call. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: Mr. President, next amendment, Senator Kristensen has an amendment, but I understand you want to withdraw, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kristensen.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Just, I do intend to withdraw that. The purpose of the amendment has been served. I withdraw it. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Janssen, the next amendment, I have a note you want to withdraw yours, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Janssen. It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Thompson. (AM2783, Legislative Journal page 1205.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Thompson, to open on your amendment, AM2783.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. I just ask your indulgence. If this doesn't move immediately, then I will withdraw it. This is a very simple bill that was advanced unanimously by the Revenue Committee. It's the only bill I've ever had advanced by the Revenue Committee, (laughter) and it simply, it was at the request of the county treasurer and with the support of the Nebraska County Treasurers and NACO.
