SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: I just wasn't clear, were you...

SENATOR CUDABACK: There are no further lights on, Senators.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Given what Senator Wickersham says, I guess, I'm uncomfortable at this point as well. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kristensen. Senator Thompson, there are no further lights on. Did you...Senator Thompson waives closing. You've heard the closing. The question before the body is, shall AM2783 be adopted to LB 968? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 16 nays on the amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Thompson amendment is not adopted. Mr. Clerk, next item to the bill.

CLERK: The next amendment, Mr. President, Senator Bromm. I understand he wants to withdraw.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment, Senator Raikes, the next two. Both amendments to be gone, Senator?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Both amendments are withdrawn.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: We are back to discussion of the bill, the advancement to E & R for engrossing. There are no lights on. Senator Wickersham, did you wish to...Senator Wickersham waives closing. Senator Smith, ready for a motion.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 968 to E & R for engrossing.
