Mr. Langel is from Norfolk. We had a hearing and our committee unanimously voted to recommend confirmation of these three appointees, Mr. Chairman. And with that, I will yield the rest of the time back to the Chair.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. Senator Chambers, on the confirmation report.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, because later on in the day I'm going to have the opportunity to expatiate free over a multitude of subjects for a long period of time, I will not take many seconds or minutes this morning in standing this morning as I do by way of a protest. This no vote is pursuant to that protest that I'm conducting throughout this session as I did last session against the skewed manner in which the Governor makes basically white male appointments. This no vote does not reflect in any way on the qualification of the three individuals who have been presented to us by our esteemed but unfortunate colleague, Senator Curt Bromm. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There are no further lights. Senator Bromm, did you wish to close? Senator Bromm waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of the confirmation report by the Transportation Committee. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Have you all voted? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal pages 1311-1312.) 33 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The adoption of confirmation is adopted. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first bill this morning on Select File, LB 1285. Senator Smith, I have Enrollment and Review amendments first of all, Senator. (AM7215, Legislative Journal page 912.)
