SENATOR WEHRBEIN: In the bottom darkened area specifically designates PSC as body of original and exclusive jurisdiction preserving district court. Should that be district court rather than just district?

SENATOR BROMM: Yes, it should. Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I could say it's nitpicking but I thought it was. But I...since I'm depending on your handout rather than going through the 31 pages, I wanted to be sure that it is the district...

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: (Laugh) I understand where it's headed and that makes sense. I just...I was just being a little picky but I was reading this morning. Thank you.

SENATOR BROMM: It makes more sense now that you pointed that out. Thank you.
