PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Jones. Senator Coordsen, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR COORDSEN: Only to say, Mr. President, members of the body, that the commission will have one person appointed by the Governor whose occupation is predominantly in the production of livestock. It does provide for a rancher, Senator Jones. And I well recognize, and all of us who are engaged in food production recognize, that there's no clear...clear bright light between any of those occupations. They're generalities, at best. With that, I would encourage the adoption of AM3052. Thank you, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Coordsen. The question is the adoption of AM3052 to LB 1124. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote no. Please record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Coordsen's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1124 to E & R for engrossing.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the advancement of LB 1124 to E & R. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 1124A, Senator Smith, I have no amendments to that bill.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1124A to E & R for engrossing.
