Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The bill is advanced. (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 973, Senator Smith, E & R amendments first of all. (AM7244, Legislative Journal page 1232.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 973.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Question is the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 973. Those in favor say aye. Those opposed nay. The amendments are agreed to.

CLERK: Senator Janssen would move to amend. (AM3053, Legislative Journal page 1287.)

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. This amendment just moves the operative date to August 1st. Otherwise, it would have been in the middle of July sometime and the Department of Revenue would like to start it on the first of August. So that is the reason for the amendment. It is only the operative date. With that, thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Discussion on the Janssen amendment? Senator Janssen, you're recognized to close. The question is the adoption of AM3053 to LB 973. Those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Janssen's amendment.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Amendment is agreed to.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Smith.

SENATOR SMITH: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 973 to E & R for engrossing.
