SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, it's a strange day.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, what did you wish to do?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Well, I guess I would ask for a call of the house and I'll take call-in votes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. All unexcused senators please report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Beutler has authorized call-in votes.

CLERK: Senator Connealy voting yes. Senator Wickersham voting no. Senator Bruning voting yes. Senator Jones voting no. Senator Dwite Pedersen...Senator Dwite, do you want to change? Changing from yes to no. Senator Dierks voting no. Senator Thompson voting no. Senator Schmitt voting no. Senator Hartnett voting no. Senator Bohike voting no. Senator Stuhr voting no. Senator Suttle voting no. Senator Price voting no. Senator Matzke voting yes. Senator Janssen voting no. Senator Byars voting no. Senator Lynch voting yes. Senator Coordsen voting no.

SENATOR CUDABACK: We're either going to take a roll call or else we're going to record. Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Ask for a roll call vote, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: There's a request for a roll call vote. The question before the body is, shall AM3090 be adopted to LB 812? Mr. Clerk, call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1349-1350.) 27 ayes, 19 nays on the amendment.
