encouraging abortions. I think we ought to explore that to the utmost. The second factor that I'm concerned about, does the search for cures, those cures sought by the various research projects, do they really require fetal tissue; is it needed, in other words? That, I think, is the second question. And, if it is needed, then there's a third question and that is, are there adequate alternative nonelective abortion...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...sources? Those three things, and then of course the question we always have when we come up with some solution, and that is, whether the solution meets both the state and the federal Constitution? So I hope, as the debate goes along, that those areas are addressed. I'm certainly going to attempt to elicit responses from the interested parties on both sides of those various questions. And if we can start to refine those things, and I think our lack of information and the great "inflation" of conflicting information has made it very difficult for you and I to act in this situation. We need to sort things out, that's part of the problem here. But, hopefully today, rather than just yelling at each other, at least for what I perceive to be the majority in this body who would like to find a way to...
