SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk, next item.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, we are back to the committee amendments. (AM2553, Legislative Journal page 814.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Schrock, as Chair of the committee, you're recognized to open on the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. Speaker, I'm going to pass over the committee amendments because the Connealy amendment will replace the committee amendments and become the bill.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Schrock, you cannot withdraw the committee amendments. I will take your...

SENATOR SCHROCK: Okay. Mr. Speaker, the committee amendments will be amended by the Connealy amendment, and that's the amendment that will become the bill. The Connealy amendment will say that all service stations must offer the product at the lowest octane level sold at that site. That's the amendment that we're going to be supporting, and that's what we think the compromise is. And a lot has been said about ethanol, lot has been said about gasoline. I just ask you where are you going to get your gasoline 40 years from now? Maybe I won't be around but my grandkids will be around, and gasoline may not be available. And that's the reason for this bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment to the committee amendments that I have is offered by Senator Schrock. This is AM2622. (Legislative Journal page 969.)

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Schrock, you're recognized...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: It is withdrawn.
