CLERK: 13 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators please check in. Senator Baker, please check in. Senator Lynch, Matzke, Dwite Pedersen, Crosby, Senator Dickey, Senator Crosby, Senator Landis. Senator Beutler has authorized call-ins. The house is under call. Please report to the Chamber and check in. The hou...Senator Suttle, Senator Thompson, Senator Kiel, the house is under call. Please check in. And Senator Beutler did authorize call-ins. The house is under call and Senator Beutler did authorize call-ins.

CLERK: Senator Crosby voting yes. Senator Brown voting yes. Senator Kiel voting yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Beutler amendment, AM3104, to the committee amendments to LB 1234 is adopted. I do raise the call.

CLERK: Senator Chambers, next amendment, FA354. (Legislative Journal page 1406.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on FA354.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, in the spirit of what everybody has said about no more mandates, on page 1 of Senator Connealy's amendment, in line 17, I would simply strike "shall" and insert "may". And I'll answer any questions that you may have.
