All present or accounted for. The question before the body is, shall the Chambers amendment, FA354, be adopted to the committee amendments of LB 1234? All in favor of the question vote aye, opposed nay. There's been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

12 ayes, 25 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Chambers amendment to the committee amendments to LB 1234 does not pass. Mr. Clerk, next item. Do raise the call, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next amendment I have, Senator Bromm, 31...oh. Mr. President, Senator Bromm, I understand you want to withdraw AM3140.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Well,...

SENATOR BROMM: Yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: And I want...I would ask leave to substitute the amendment that I brought to the Clerk's desk.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Seeing no objection, it is substituted.
