SENATOR BAKER: Very quickly, Senator Cudaback, thank you. I do still think this amendment is important. If it does not pass, I suspect it...and this bill does move to Select File, I suspect we're going to get a whole lot more input from retailers and so on as to some of the problems it's going to create, so I sincerely hope that you consider this and vote for it. I really think that we have no guarantees, as Senator Chambers pointed out. The only terminal that I know of in Nebraska right now that handles any 85 octane fuel is at Sidney and they...that's because they ship fuel into the Rocky Mountain area. I don't know how fast they can get this here. The pipeliners that I've talked to or the jobbers that I've talked to say they're going to have dedicate some tanks at the tank farms at Doniphan, North Platte, Sidney, and Beatrice. I don't know how this is going to work out. I don't have that letter from Williams brothers Pipe Lines, but apparently they will get it here. I don't know at what price. It may surprise us. We...they were not set up for 85 octane. It may...it may cost us just as much 87 octane. I don't know that. I don't think anybody knows that. So I would urge adoption of my amendment and we'll go on from there. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. You've heard the closing on the Baker amendment to the committee amendments. The question before the body is, shall the Baker amendment, AM3147, be adopted to the committee amendments to LB 1234? All in favor of the question vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the Baker amendment to the committee amendments. Have you all voted who care to? Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: I'm going to have to ask for a call of the house and a roll call vote, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question before the body is, shall the house go under call? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.
