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marinas. The implementation date would be October 1st, the year 2000. We would ban the use of MTBE as of July 1st of the year 2000. I think that's a pretty concise summary of where we're at right now. It's kind of where we want to keep the bill. With that, we will address amendments as they are offered.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock, for filling us in. Amendments, Mr. Clerk, next item to the bill.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Jones would move to amend the committee amendments with AM3149. (AM3149, Legislative Journal page 1417.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jones, to open on your bill...or amendment, excuse me.

SENATOR JONES: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. We had a lot of discussion yesterday on the 87 percent that they have to offer at every station and I still am confused on that because I think that that would...wouldn't allow them to have a tank without it in it, the way that it reads, and I think it needs to be cleared up. So I'm coming back with this amendment saying that 87 percent and below does not have to have ethanol in, and same with 91 percent and above does not have to have it in, and I think that that would solve a lot of the problems on the bulk tanks in a lot of the areas that do not want to have the ethanol for their...just their summer running tractors and things like that that they're concerned about. So my amendment would amend that and take out the part of the...on the allowing it to any station have to have...any station would have to have it and put in this part saying that if they need it, well, they can have it in 88, 89, and 90, still have it. And I think a lot of the stations eastern part of the state, they've got three pumps or more. They can have it in it and no problem. You get out in mine, in the mom and pop stations and ones with just two pumps and they've got a big delivery area, they wouldn't have to have it in the 87 percent and below. And that's what my amendment does and I'd appreciate your support on it. Thank you.
