SENATOR CUDABACK: Yes, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Could I ask that we check in to be sure that we're all here.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Yes, I'd like to remind the body that the house is still under call. Senators, please check in. Looking for Senator Lynch, Senator Robak, Senator Janssen. The house is under call. Senator Lynch, Senator Janssen, Senator Robak. Senator Janssen. I believe he's with a group of students. Senator Chambers says that we may go on. The question before the body is the adoption of the Chambers amendment, FA357, to the committee amendments to LB 1234. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We are voting on the Chambers amendment, FA357, to the committee amendments to FA...I mean to LB 1234. Have you all voted who care to? There's been a request for a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1418.) 17 ayes, 21 nays on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Chambers amendment was not adopted. Mr. Clerk, next item. Raise the call please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Baker would move to amend, AM3154. (Legislative Journal page 1418.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you Senator Cudaback and members. This is an amendment actually to Senator Bromm's amendment that we adopted last night. It is in the Journal...the amendment is printed. All it does, well, we need to back up. Senator Bromm's amendment exempted locations with two or fewer fuel storage tanks available for retail sale of motor fuel, and what this amendment does is strike "motor fuel" and says gas...or substitutes "gasoline"; tanks that's available for retail sale of gasoline. I had several phone calls this morning saying we offer, and don't laugh at us but out west there is still people sell kerosene for winter use, off-road diesel, various tanks and so on, and the one person that called me, visited with, said I
