more corn, and there are a lot more plants in Nebraska that process corn for all sorts of things, whether it be plastic, corn syrup, the alcohol, the ethanol that it's made from. Now I believe that, you know, I've got no bones to pick with the petroleum industry. I have a lot of friends, a lot of constituents that are in the petroleum business. I understand the hardships that maybe this bill would have brought on to them, but I believe that with the amendments that have been filed, we've taken care of a lot of those problems. Now I'm going to...I'll support Senator Baker's amendment. I think it's something we didn't think of yesterday, but I'm still going to support the use of ethanol in this state. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Senator Schrock, on the Baker amendment to the committee amendments. Senator Schrock, you're recognized.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Baker, I would accept that amendment if you'd refine it more. The trouble is you're providing a way for people to circumvent the law. If I have five tanks out there and all of a sudden I'm going to dedicate one of them to kerosene, one of them to winter blend fuel and one of them to summer blend fuel, all of a sudden I only have two tanks left for gasoline. Do you understand what I'm saying? It doesn't work. I would work on your refining this amendment, but I can't accept it because it's a way for people to circumvent the intent of the law here. I hope you understand that. If you want to work on it on Select File or later, fine, I'll help you, but I can't accept it the way it is because it gives people a chance to play games and it won't work. I hope that's clear and I hope everybody understands that I don't want to...I don't want to take away people's options here, but somebody can have seven tanks and dedicated five of them to something else besides gasoline. That amendment is going to take some time and work. Senator Baker, if you will withdraw it, I will work with you on that, but because of the problems it involves, and I hope you understand, I can't accept it in its present form. Do I make any sense? I'll work with you on it, I really will, but this just, if they have five tanks, they'll dedicate three of them to something else and say, well, I've only got two tanks left for gasoline, sorry, I can't sell ethanol. And that's what's going to happen.
