grant process. It is \$50,000 that must be matched by the applicants. This is not money that will flow out that has no responsibility attached to it. There will be quite a bit of oversight. There are reporting requirements attached to this. No one can apply for more than one grant in one year, and not for the same project. So it is not a significant amount of funding compared to the kind of funding that we've been providing to different entities this year. It provides for a lot of responsibility on the part of the applicants, significant oversight in terms of the College of Architecture. It goes to rural communities, and we all have rural communities in our districts, for the most part and, if we don't have a rural community in our district, we certainly have neighborhood communities in our district. And it will do a great deal of good at the place where I consider to be the most important, and that is the local level. It is grassroots in nature, and it is for a small amount of money that I think we can well afford to spend this year. Thank you.
