SENATOR CUDABACK: There's been...there's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call please vote aye, opposed nay. Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 0 nays to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators please check in. The house is under call.

CLERK: Senator Wehrbein voting yes. Senator Kristensen voting yes. Senator Beutler voting yes. Senator Smith voting yes. Senator Vrtiska voting yes. Senator Hilgert voting yes. Senator Kremer voting yes. Senator Schimek, you had voted yes, Senator. Senator Schmitt voting yes.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Record, please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments are adopted to LB 1003. I do raise the call. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Wickersham would move to amend. (AM2806, Legislative Journal page 1057.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Wickersham, to open on AM2806 to LB 1003. Senator Wickersham.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Mr. President, members of the body, this is really a simple amendment. You can read it, it's only four lines long. This bill would establish a new kind of a program. The program contemplates solicitation of participation by citizens of the state of Nebraska and others. I believe that it is appropriate that that solicitation be made in the state of Nebraska or the plan but not be made in the name of an individual officeholder. The program is to be administered by the State Treasurer. It's my belief that the solicitations for this program ought to go out in the name of the office, not in
