the name of the individual that holds the office. We're advertising, literally, for participation in a state program. For example, if you want someone to participate in NIFA, you don't advertise in the name of the person that is executive director for NIFA, you advertise in the name of NIFA. That's all the amendment does; it just says you're going to promote this as a function of the Treasurer's Office of the state of Nebraska rather than a function of Dave Heineman, State Treasurer.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. You've heard the opening on AM2806 to LB 1003. We are open for discussion. Senator Schrock.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I haven't checked with Mr. Heineman, but I think Senator Wickersham brings us a reasonable amendment and I will support it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. Senator Wickersham, there are no further lights. Did you wish to close on your amendment? I'm sorry, the light...Senator Brashear, did you wish to talk on the amendment?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Yes, Mr. President, members of the body. This strikes me as silly. For as long as I can remember, and I'm getting older and older by the moment, politicians on all sides of the aisle have been conducting their offices as they see fit and we elect them or we defeat them, and that's life. Now, this might be a great reform movement Senator Wickersham is starting here, if we did it throughout all of the statutes. But to do it one time on one bill as to one officeholder, I think, is silly, and it might even be a little less than that, and I think we ought to reject it. If we're going to do this, then let's do it across the board for everybody, all the way. I'd urge the defeat of the Wickersham amendment.
