ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to amend the committee amendments. (AM3177, Legislative Journal page 1434.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, to open on your amendment to the committee amendments to LB 1067. Your amendment is AM3177.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature, this is, frankly, an effort to salvage two important things that I think everybody has agreed upon. They come out of the bill LB 1234, the ethanol bill which we just rejected, and what the amendment would do would be to add to this bill the water monitoring amendment and also the MTBE amendment, whether we adopt it, neither of which were at all controversial. So, Mr. Speaker, I would move to suspend the rules and ask the body to adopt these amendments to the bill as germane. (Laughter)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, will you come up and submit your motion in writing. He wants to...Senator Beutler. Senator Beutler. The motion was not in writing, Senator Beutler.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Beutler would move to suspend the rules, Rule 7, Section 3(d), to permit consideration of AM3177.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, move to suspend the rules, you open on your motion. Senator Beutler, open on your motion.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature, I think there's been, obviously, some consternation with regard to how those...how these two matters are going to be handled and, although I thought the marching orders were straight, I guess they were not straight and so, for the moment at least, I'll withdraw the motion.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion is withdrawn. We're open for debate on the committee amendment. Senator Schrock. Senator Schrock, you're recognized. Senator Schrock waives. We're open for discussion on the committee amendments to LB 1067. Senator Wickersham, there are no further lights, would you wish to close on the committee amendments? Senator Wickersham waives closing, as Chairperson of Revenue Committee, on the committee
