a secure or nonsecure detention. Sections 8 through 10 of the committee amendment include provisions of LB 1167, Senator Thompson's bill. Creates a Juvenile Diversion, Detention, and Probation Services Implementation Team consisting of 26 members; 22 members are appointed by the Governor with a variety of relevant backgrounds and experience; the State Probation Administrator, the Administrators of HHS Protection and Safety Division, and the state...and then also two state senators. Sections 21 through 31 of the committee amendment include provisions of LB 1164. It combines two existing standing committees of the Nebraska Crime Commission into one grant program for the disbursement of state and federal juvenile justice funds. The bill establishes the Nebraska Coalition for Juvenile Justice and eliminates the Juvenile Services Grant Committee. The coalition consists of 15 to 33 members appointed by the Governor. Membership for the committee is deleted and new membership criteria for the coalition inserted. At least one-fifth of the coalition members must be under the age of 25. That is a federal requirement. And a majority of the coalition members, including the chairperson, cannot be full-time federal, state or local government employees. It deletes the detailed requirements in current law for plans submitted to the coalition and only requires that the plans comply with rules and regulations adopted under the state and federal law. The amendment deletes the detailed criteria for grant awards in the current law and requires only that the Crime Commission approve eligibility criteria for the awards. The emergency clause applies to portions of LB 1167 in the committee amendment; portions of LB 1392 in the amendment become operative on January 1 of 2001. Provisions of LB 1164 become operative on July 1 of 2001.
