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to and I've written those up separately as amendments, but I will hold them off until Select File so that they will be printed and you'll have a chance to see them. This is also, I have to confess, the last chance to do work on the banking issues and again, consistent with Senator Kristensen's admonition, that body of work which the committee has done, which was unanimously reported out and which would normally be done on a consent calendar basis, I will try to put into an amendment. I will publicize that. I will give you all a chance to take a look at it, but I will offer it on Select File and it will have two elements in it. It will have those suggestions by the director and, secondly, it will have some pieces that the committee reported out unanimously after hearings but on several other measures which are now languishing on consent calendar, and you'll have a chance to examine those. Of course, I'll explain them fully, but it is my intention to offer them on Select File. I would ask for the adoption of these committee amendments at this time. Thank you.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: You've heard the opening on the committee amendments. Debate on the committee amendments? Seeing none, Senator Landis. He waives the closing of the committee amendments. The question before the body is the adoption of those amendments. All in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Please record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: The committee amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Landis, AM2848. I have a note you want to withdraw AM2848, Senator. Mr. President, Senator Landis also has AM3130. Again, I have note that you would like to withdraw at this time, Senator. That's all that I have on the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. We're now debating advancement of the bill. Senator Schrock. Senator Schrock, your light was on. He waives. Any debate on the advancement of the bill? Seeing none, Senator Landis, you're recognized to close on advancement of the bill.
