would also authorize the board members to obtain health insurance benefits. Is that correct?

SENATOR SCHROCK: They do that now, I believe. Yes, they do that now.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Okay. It looks to me like the amendment, though, and you can correct me if I'm wrong, would, if their health insurance benefits would be paid out of their total compensation right now, but it looks like the amendment would have that included on top of any additional pay raise that they may get out of this.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Senator Quandahl, I can explore that with you on...on...and we could discuss that on Select File, if you want, but...

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Yeah, I don't...and just, Senator Schrock, for the body's edification too, I don't intend to slow the entire process of this bill down, but I do have some fairly serious concerns with this pay raise being included in the committee amendments. The actual...

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: One minute.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: ...modifications to the Power Review Board I think are fine and dandy, but tacking on the pay raise for the board of directors, I'm not so sure that that would be a financially wise thing to do at this point. And so I may...I will discuss this with you, and perhaps I'll have an amendment to put up on Select File.

SENATOR SCHROCK: That's fine, Senator. That's fair.

SENATOR QUANDAHL: Thanks. I'd yield the rest of my time back to the Chair.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: Senator Preister.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Honorable President. I am pleased that the LR 455 study, that took a lot of time, a lot of commitment, a lot of involvement by a lot of parties, has
