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especially and maybe starting before that they teach the dignity of work and they teach that people should do the best they can even at that age and get a job where they can apply those skills and be proud of it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Lynch. Senator Price, on the Stuhr amendment, followed by Senator Crosby.

SENATOR PRICE: Mr. President and members of the body, in Lincoln as we get ready to build two new high schools and as we have built other schools over the past few years, we find that we do not have people trained in the skills to which we need, you know, whether it be masons, whether it be electricians, plumbers, and people that work with their hands and are a very vital part of putting up a good building. And so probably we'll be building one high school before we build the other high school. We can bid it out, get a good cost there, but it's the thing of building the two buildings at the same time which would be ideal in my estimation. Many students when they graduate from high school know they're not going to be able to afford even a two-year college much less five-year education. And so what they have learned in school through what we used to call shop and so forth now they're learning in voc ed and career preparation. Many of these young people then have their own business established and they do real well and some of them just never aspire to get a diploma, a master's degree, a doctorate. And these are very key people because the people that aspire for high goals they can do it, but for the people who work with their hands that are happy and are good at doing what they're doing, we need to be supportive and I'm supportive of the Stuhr amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Price. Senator Crosby, on AM3193. Senator Crosby, that won't be necessary beings your light is last, thank you. Senator Stuhr, there are no further lights. Would you like to close on your amendment to your LB 495?
