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clarification for the Auditor's Office and for the fire districts. I ask for your support of LB 1304, it just clarifies what...the commitment we made five years ago and answers a few questions. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Senator Schimek, open on the committee amendments.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes, thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I'll give you the short version, because that's really all there is here. It's a very simple technical amendment. At one place in the bill, where it talks about the auditor either approving or denying these waivers, it says approval or denial will be received in writing. Later on in the bill, on page 4, on line 14, it only indicates that the approval will be in writing, so this is very much a technical amendment that says "or denial", that's added in there. So I don't think any further explanation is probably in order or necessary. Thank you.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Schimek. For debate on the committee amendments, Senator Cudaback. Debate on the committee amendments, Senator Vrtiska?

SENATOR VRTISKA: On the bill.
