PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Committee amendments are agreed to. Debate on the advancement of LB 825? Senator Price, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR PRICE: Mr. President, members of the body, I'm getting whimpers and meows as people are going up and down the aisles, and you know that just sounds really good. Cap Dierks is in Denver. I wished he was here because I picked up this bill upon the urging of some wonderful people here in town, my staff, my previous staff and my current staff, I sound like the Academy Awards, don't I, and it has just come to fruition and I would be happy to answer any questions that anybody has today, and I appreciate the support of the Ag Committee.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Price. Question is the advancement of LB 825. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 825.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The bill is advanced. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 825A, by Senator Price. (Read title.)

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Price, you're recognized to open on the appropriation bill to LB 825.

SENATOR PRICE: The bill will be supported by funding from the licensing and...and the funds will then be used to fund the inspection, and it should be a self-supporting, if you bring it up on your gadget, it should be a self-supporting fund, and I urge your support of this fiscal statement. Thank you.
