PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Jensen. Discussion on the confirmation report of the Health Committee. Senator Jensen, you're recognized to close. Senator Jensen waives closing. The question is the adoption of the confirmation report of the Health Committee. Those in favor vote aye, those opposed nay. Mr. Clerk, please record.

CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal page 1481.) 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: The report is agreed to.

CLERK: Second report, Mr. President, by Health and Human Services involving appointments to the Board of Emergency Medical Services, and Excellence in Health Care Council.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Jensen, you're recognized to open on the confirmation report.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President. The second report includes two individuals. The first is Robert Olson to the EMS Board. He was appointed for a...reappointment for a three-year term; an insurance agent from Papillion, Nebraska, current chair of the EMS Board, and has been active in the EMA and a community volunteer for many, many years. He was part of the original task force that set up the EMS...EMS Board across the state of Nebraska, has had many years of volunteerism and work in this area. The second individual is John Klosterman to the Excellence in Health Care Council; a reappointment to a three-year term. Initially, that was a one-year term. He is a farmer from David City and a graduate of Doane College. He was unable to appear in person at the hearing, and Senator Bromm appeared in his behalf. He is a past director of Nebraska Rural Health Association, has done a great deal of work in both the health field and in banking and in farming in the David City area. I would recommend these two individuals to the full Legislature for confirmation. Thank you, Mr. President.
