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bottom and work up to the 30 percent if you are going to do something, and say that you've got to offer an accredited system, you've got to offer pre...you've got to offer pre-K child care services, and in that case you'll get the full load, but only in that case would you get the full load, instead of piling on as Senator Suttle suggests. I am recalling testimony in the Revenue Committee on this bill from a person representing a large financial institution in this town. You can look him up and see that he came and represented that institution. He said, for the public record, that they had investigated the cost of an on-site child care facility. They had investigated the cost of an on-site child care facility and found that they could not do that cheaper than off-site child care providers. They could not on site, that is in their building, provide child care cheaper than could be provided by off-site child care providers. So they were in favor of this bill because the credits would allow them to have an on-site child care facility. Now, Senator Suttle, what does that do for those folks who are out there running their independent child care facilities? Doesn't that take business away from them?

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: Doesn't that mean that we're "incenting" uneconomic costs? Doesn't that mean that we're "incenting" something that could be more economically provided by competition in the full private sector? Why should the state, why should the state incent that kind of uneconomic behavior and take business away from folks who are maybe already struggling a little bit? Why should we do that? I don't understand.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Senator Beutler, on the Suttle amendment.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Landis, I'm coming late to this debate and I'm sorry, but I would like to ask you a few questions.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Senator Landis.

SENATOR BEUTLER: And if I'm being repetitive, just say I'm being repetitive and I'll talk off the floor to you since it
