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center. The other kinds of costs that you might have in terms of overhead, depreciation, generalized maintenance of a larger facility, et cetera, I don't know how you're going to attribute those. So those aren't included,...

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: One minute.

SENATOR WICKERSHAM: ...but I don't think it's appropriate to include them. And, again, I would urge support of the amendment, if nothing else as a fail-safe so that there is some definition in the bill in case you didn't happen to like Senator Landis' definition that he's going to offer later.

PRESIDENT MAURSTAD: Thank you, Senator Wickersham. Senator Landis.

SENATOR LANDIS: I almost waived off. I just...once these issues get joined you just have a tough time avoiding the chance to talk. Look, ever have a four-year-old child? There are plumbing options that are designed for a four-year-old child that are of a different size than for adults. A building now used by adults, part of a going concern, that's going to get changed to a child care unit probably going to have, quite legitimately, different plumbing, different fixtures. Where's the sink for a four-year-old? What's the size of the johnny for a four-year-old, or the urinal? What about the lockers that you might have or the space for hanging up coats? They're different and those are remodeling costs and the Wickersham amendment doesn't have anything in for that. In fact, you don't get any credit for it at all. I object to the AM2707 on the narrowness of the grounds. I don't object to the concept that costs ought to be defined and I'll...we would not be foolish enough to pass a bill without a definition. You know that and I know that. The timing of it is one thing. If we need to make a counter offer let me suggest that we adopt my amendment on General File and then improve it on Select File rather than offering on Select File, but certainly not the Wickersham amendment. This happens rather all the time because there are certainly technical areas that any bill can be improved on, but I...I'm not sure I want the opponents of the bill to define the bill. I think the opponents of the bill want to kill the bill. Senator Wickersham has already said that if the Hilgert amendment was
