Governor can veto probably enough back before we go home to have it balanced, that we have that obligation, too, so...

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Hoping for increased revenue is about the only alternative at this stage if we override these vetoes and adopt the pending A bills, isn't it?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, yeah, I, definitely in my mind, there is not room for all the A bills that are coming. That...I mean, the body still has to sort that out.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: So we're making some critical choices this afternoon that affect every other pending circumstance, is that correct?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes, just as it was when we started day one here.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: As it always is. Thank you, sir.

SPEAKER KRISTENSEN: (Visitors introduced.) Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BROMM: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members of the Legislature. It took me two, or three, or four years when I came here to even to begin to try to understand the General Fund Financial Status sheet that's attached to the agenda, and I'm still not sure that I totally understand it, but I have taken a look at it, and as I read the proposed override motion of the committee, I secured a copy of the sheet that I think Senator Wehrbein was just talking about, which puts us in the 2002-2003 biennium, if we approve the bills that are pending on Final Reading and E & R Final and Select File, at \$48,753,000 over. And then Senator Brashear made a very valid point, some of the bills that are not yet passed that will be coming through, in my mind I have to...I have to think about some of those as opposed to some of the priorities that the Appropriations Committee is asking us to approve for an override. One or two of these might be as important or more important than many of the bills that I can think of that we haven't passed yet. But there are some things in that package that simply don't meet the priority test for me in terms of having a limited amount of money and a lot of things that need to be done.
