SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's the boxes you're talking about.

SENATOR RAIKES: Right.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right, the bottom two boxes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Right.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Right.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay, now as I understand it, with this amendment, with this override, the bottom left number would become about a plus \$7.6 million, the bottom right number would be about a minus \$49 million, is that correct?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: That's...that's correct.

SENATOR RAIKES: Okay, one other question.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I'm going to pass that out, by the way.

SENATOR RAIKES: Oh, good, okay, so everybody can see that.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Which...what are we required to do by law? We're required to budget so that we have at least a minimum reserve. Now is that for, is that just the lower left hand box or is that the lower right hand box?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: It's the lower left hand box.

SENATOR RAIKES: So, in other words, after this, if this override were successful, we would have \$7.6 million over the minimum reserve if all other bills passed, Select, or excuse...yes, Select and Final, I think that doesn't include any General File bills, A bills, okay.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes.

SENATOR RAIKES: We would have a plus \$7.6 million, but we would
